OVERSTAY

- 1. Overstay is a violation of section 15 (1) (c) of Immigration Act 1959/63, an offence under section 15 (4) of the Act. The offender can be fined not less than RM 10,000 of face imprisonment not exceeding five (5) years or both. UMP will not be responsible for any offence committed by its student.
- 2. The student may be blacklisted and deported back to home country. Student can be prohibited to enter Malaysia for a period of time. UMP will also impose a daily penalty charge for overstayed students.
